## Provisions for Each Sled Team

We will provide hot water. Each sled is responsible for its own garbage and trash. What you bring in—you must bring out. We do not have adequate facilities to handle all the trash.

### **Klondike Sled Provisions**

- 1 Homemade Sled \*
- 6' long Snow Snake\* or Pole
- 10 feet of 3/8" inch (Manila or Braided Nylon) rope with ends whipped or fused
- 1 Quart of Water Minimum Per Sled
- Hot Drink Mix for each Scout – Hot Cocoa, Jell-O or .....
- Hot Liquid Cups or Mugs per Scout
- Spoon for each Scout
- Hot Spark ("Magnesium Match" + Steel Striker)
- Tinder- 14" ball of Pulled Sisal Rope – Strands pulled and separated, then balled together
- Sleeping Bag or Blanket
- Trash Bag
- Patrol Flag
- Patrol First Aid Kit
- 1 pair Wool Socks
- Scout or Webelos Scout Handbook
- Each Scout properly attired for weather + event. No cotton "sweats" or sneakers.
- Patrol Cheer/yell
- Hand + Foot warmers for each Scout

### **Mountain Man Sled Provisions (14-Year Old Scout Teams Only)**

- 1 Homemade Sled\*
- Axe with Sheath – Approx. 2 ¼ - 2 ½ lb. Head; 27 -28" Handle; Maximum Total Wt. is 4 lbs.  
**Axes will be weighed.**
- 1 Quart of Water Minimum Per Sled
- Hot Drink Mix for each Scout – Hot Cocoa, Jell-O or .....
- 1 Hot Liquid Cup or Mug per Scout
- Sleeping Bag or Blanket
- Trash Bag
- Patrol Flag
- Patrol First Aid Kit
- 1 pair Wool Socks
- Each Scout properly attired for weather + event. No cotton "sweats" or sneakers.
- Patrol Cheer/yell
- Hand + Foot warmers for each Scout
