Mayflower Council 2019 Merit Badge University Counselor Survey Results

Introduction

Following the 2019 Mayflower Merit Badge University in March a survey was sent to the 200 merit badge counselors who taught at this event. The purpose was to gather information on their experience to help the advancement committee plan for future merit badge universities.

Of the 200 counselors, 96 responded across 42 of the 50 merit badges offered. This response shows a good response rate and that the results are worthwhile in making future decisions.

Q. Please rate the teaching space you were assigned.

The previous 2 tables indicate that 15 students (on average) is an appropriate number. This was the default number this past year. Our registration system currently has the ability to limit class for each merit badge. In the future, we will be guided by the responses from individual merit badges counselors in setting class size for their respective merit badges.

Q. Scheduling Preferences

This question asked counselors to rate their preferences on 3 scheduling options for the merit badge university. Option 1 and 2 are **two** weekend schedules. Option 3 is a **three** weekend schedule. Option 1 was the schedule used in 2019. Please note that in all cases there is an "off weekend" to provide an opportunity for troop campouts and "homework".

It appears that counselors **prefer a 2 weekend schedule** per their rankings of options 1 and 2 as their 1st choice. However, the choice between options 1 and 2 as the 1st choice is the same. Their 2nd choice seems to prefer option 2 a bit more (43 vs. 34).
