Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)

April 2



Welcome to BALOO training! It is the Cub Scout leader training required for any Cub Scout den or pack outdoor event, including pack camping overnights and Webelos den overnights. BALOO training is comprised of two components—an online component and a practical, hands-on component. Both components must be completed to qualify as a “TRAINED” Cub Scout outdoor leader. The online component must be completed prior to the practical component. The online training contains introductory and basic information that will be built upon during the practical training.





Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)

April 2, Nov 5



Completing this hands-on overnight training course will help you:

Learn new skills.

Reinforce skills you might already know—and make sure you're using the latest BSA-approved methods.

Build confidence to teach these skills and to take your Scouts camping!

For Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters, this course is part of the requirements to wear the “Trained” patch and be considered “trained” for your position. It’s also part of the requirements for adult leaders of a Venturing Crew that runs an outdoor program.

All participants must register by the weekend before the course.
