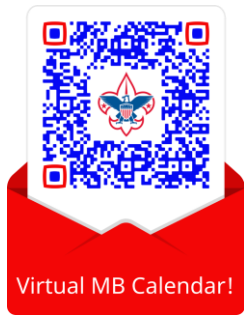


Baloo the Builder Workshops

- Reach out to schedule your workshop now!

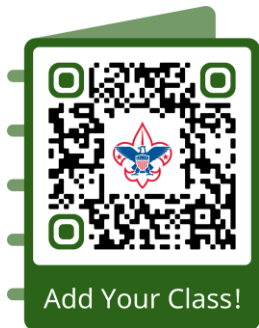




Virtual Merit Badge Classes

- Share your skills in the new year with scouts excited to learn! Follow the QR Code BELOW to register your next Virtual MB Class



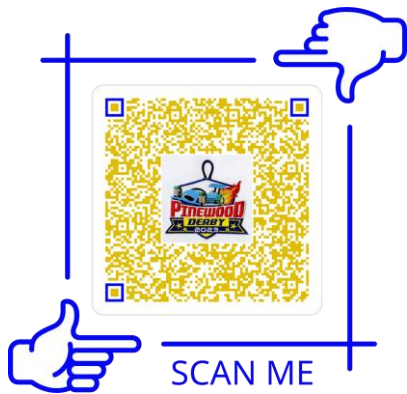


Mayflower Adventure Boxes

Everything you need to complete
an adventure in one box!

- Boxes are available for rent directly from the Mayflower website
- 3 Belt Loop or Pin options per rank
- Each \$20 rental is mailed to the leader's house with a return shipping label to return to the council office by the end of the 2-week rental period
- Inside is a list of items to keep and items that must be returned
- Each kit will include supplies for up to 10 scouts
- Once you have completed the adventure:
 - Repackage the returnable items in the original package
 - Attach the return label
 - Drop off at your local shipping location
