6 Fall Recruiting Tips (from Aaron on Scouting)

- 1. Make sure the information in your BeAScout pin is up to date; follow up on all the leads you get through the BeAScout system.**
- 2. Maintain honest and open communication with the school or host facility of your choice.**
- 3. Reach out to Mayflower Council for information or resources they have for recruiting new families in your community.**
- 4. Have youth present at your recruiting night.**
- 5. Be aware that most prospective families don't know a thing about Scouting.**
- 6. Keep it short and sweet.**

Promote the Recruiter Strip

- The Recruiter Strip has just one requirement: recruit a friend into Scouting.
- Any youth member — in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, Venturing or Sea Scouts — who gets a friend, classmate or relative to sign up for Scouting can receive the red, white and blue patch.
- Each Scout unit comes up with its own procedure for awarding the strip. In most packs, troops, crews and ships, the young person receives the strip the first time he or she successfully recruits someone into the unit.

Unit Renewal Process

Start with Login: At My.Scouting.org and go to Organization Manager (Unit Leader, Committee Chair, Chartered Organization Representative, or COR designee have access).

- 1 Click On “Unit Renewal” on the menu
- 2 Validate Information
- 3 Review Information: Make any necessary changes.
- 4 Enter your name in the signature field
- 5 Pay and Submit

The annual charter agreement is mandatory and must be obtained outside of the electronic process. After completing the updated charter agreement, please file it in the unit’s records at the council office.



Steps for Individual Renewal

- 1 Select the Notice Icon Found in the top right corner
- 2 Select pop up option "Registration for John Doe is expiring soon, click here to renew."
- 3 Review Information Select "Go To Payment"
- 4 Agree to the Terms & Conditions
- 5 Confirm / Edit Scout Life subscription
- 6 Enter / Confirm Credit Card info
- 7 Select "Place Order"
- 8 Select "Complete Registration"



SAFEGUARDING YOUTH TRAINING (SYT) Discussion

Youth Protection Training Replaced with ***SAFEGUARDING YOUTH TRAINING***

- Must be renewed **ANNUALLY**
- Email reminders start 90 days from expiration
- *Ensure your email & member ID on my.scouting.org is correct & monitored!*
- Start with log in to your my.scouting account
- Click on the training icon
- Initial course ~90 Minutes
 - Intro, 6 modules ~15 min. each, 20 question quiz, 80% is passing
 - Course remembers progress, can stop and restart mid-module, but completing module recommended
 - Optional audio for each module intro, or can read text on screen
 - Must complete module video before advancing to next one
- Annual refresher 15-20 min with test
- Current YPT Valid through expiration date but *recommend ALL VOLUNTEERS complete the new SAFEGUARDING YOUTH TRAINING soon*
 - Significant new content on technology, bullying, and reporting

Every Scout that attends will earn their Bobcat Rank.

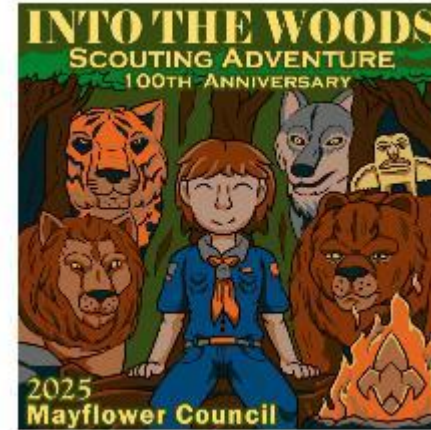
They will also earn in requirements pulled from 3 – 5 different Loops depending on the Scout Rank.
